Imagine a wardrobe; Each piece of clothing Represents one keyword, But they all hang in the closet For example, don't write 1article Write many to cover all queries Within a specific category, Then internal link them.



Okay, so how do we find them?

- 1) Go to your keyword research tool
- 2) Research your primary keyword
- 3) Collect relevant/related KWS
- 4) Add them to a spreadsheet
- 5) Add a column for "cluster"
- 6) Start grouping KWs
- 7) Scan competitors
- 8) Scan SERPS


Clusters come with massive advantages:
